



Memorandum of Understanding
between
National Council for Cement and Building Materials, Ballabgarh
and
National Productivity Council, New Delhi



This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into this 15th day of January, 2021

Between

National Council for Cement and Building Materials, through its Director General (hereinafter referred to as **NCCBM**), an apex research organization under the administrative control of Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India and a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, as amended time to time, with *inter alia* objectives to promote research and scientific work connected with Cement, Building Materials, and allied industry, including, but not limited to technology development, technology transfer, continuing education, and industrial services for cement and construction industries. The registered office of NCCBM is located at Ballabgarh, Haryana while the regional centre at Hyderabad. The project offices of NCCBM are located in Ahmedabad and Bhubaneshwar. All the offices are administratively controlled by the registered office at Ballabgarh Haryana, (which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof includes its successors and permitted substitutes) of the one part;




National Productivity Council, under DPIIT, M/o Commerce and Industry, Government of India, hereinafter referred to as NPC having its registered Office (HQ) at Utpadakta Bhawan, 5-6 Institutional Area, Lodhi Road, New Delhi- 110003, represented by the Secretary, NPC, (which expression unless it be repugnant to, or excluded by the context or meaning thereof be deemed to mean and include its successors, assignees,) second part.

The parties to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) i.e. NCCBM and NPC together will now be referred to as "the institutions" for all purpose covered under this MoU.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed between the institutions with the objective of fostering collaboration between the institutions to promote research, development & innovation activity at both the institutions. Accordingly, NCCBM and NPC agree to the following understanding amongst themselves:

1. Both the institutions i.e. NCCBM and NPC shall facilitate sharing of their infrastructure / laboratories facilities, library, and materials including proprietary software of the institutions and other in house developed components with each
