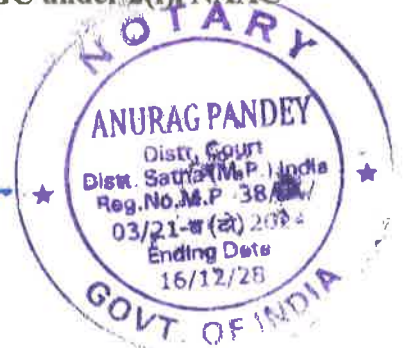

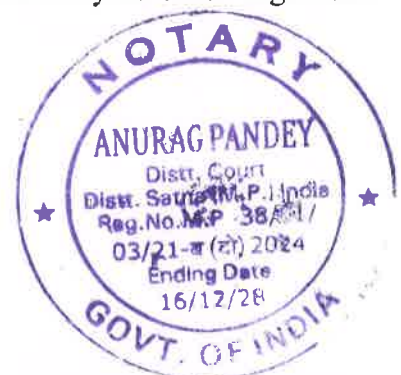

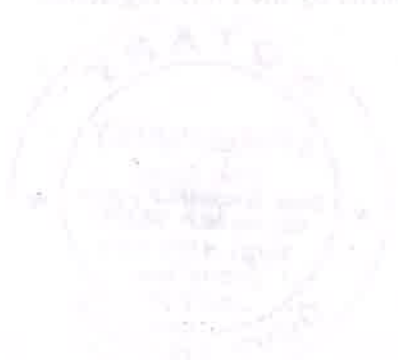

- Students of Cement Technology at AKS University will be provided training on the NCB Cement Simulator at NCB, Ballabgarh, on a chargeable basis. The training charges shall be mutually agreed upon by NCB, Ballabgarh, and AKS University, Satna.
- AKS University, Satna, shall promote and market the Post Graduate Diploma Programme conducted by NCB at its Ballabgarh unit for the admission of students from Satna and other regions.

NCB and AKSU, Satna will put in place adequate and reasonable measures to keep confidential information secure to prevent any unauthorized use. There will be no restriction on the publication of the results of collaborative research, except where such outcome has implications for the security of the State. NCB and AKSU, Satna will be free to carry out follow-up research independently. Rights regarding publications, patents, royalty, ownership of software/design/products etc., developed under the scope of this MoU, shall be decided by mutual discussion. Separate policy documents in this regard will be framed, consistent with the rules and regulations of NCB and AKSU, Satna.

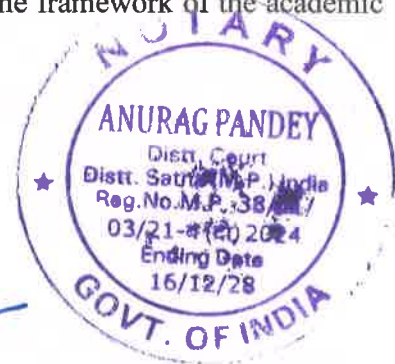
NCB and AKSU, Satna will jointly develop and devise implementation strategies and time-bound action plans to effectively meet the desired objectives and goals. Financial arrangements for each specific activity will be decided on a case-to-case basis and brought on record in each case after due approval from heads of NCB and AKSU, Satna.

A joint Coordination Committee consisting of a nominee of Director General, NCB as Chairman, and a nominee of Vice-Chancellor, AKSU, Satna as Co-Chairman, and two nominees each from NCB and AKSU, Satna, would coordinate and monitor the academic and research programmes and all related operational matters within the framework of the academic regulations of AKSU, Satna and the objectives of NCB.

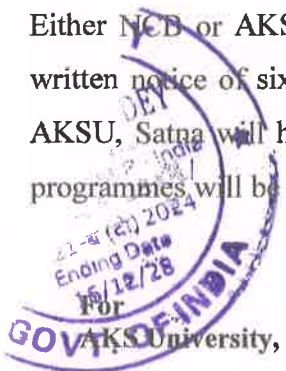

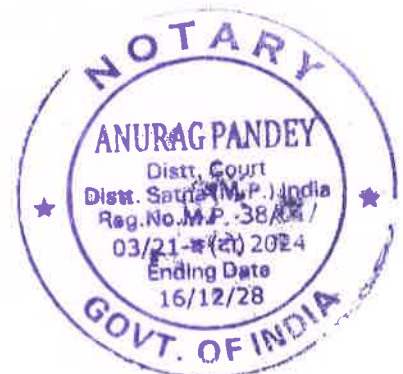
