

Summer Training/ Internship programmes at NCCBM

NCCBM offers Summer Training / Internship programmes to graduate/postgraduate students who would like to pursue their academic projects from 01 - 06 months as part of their academic curriculum. Students are advised to visit NCCBM's website (www.ncbindia.com) to get prior information on various R&D projects/activities being undertaken at NCCBM.

Terms and Conditions for Summer Training/ Internship programmes at NCCBM

- A maximum of 30 Students in total (for all departments) in all subjects from Universities/institutions/colleges are permitted at a time for Summer Training / Internship programmes at NCCBM. Director-General reserves the right to increase or decrease number of interns depending upon the merit list. Students from institutional collaborations will also be covered under this.
- Students for training / Internship programmes at NCCBM have to submit a recommendation letter from their Head of Organization/Department on their Institutional Letter Head along with the CV & Identity card copy. Letter to be addressed to:

- Applications received will be screened based on marks/grade. Students with CGPA 6.0 (60% marks) and above from IIT's/NIT's/ Institutes of eminence and CGPA 6.5 (65% marks) and above from other universities will be eligible for training at NCCBM. Preference will be given to students coming from reputed organizations like IITs, NITs and Universities.
- After screening, students will be called for online/ offline interaction with the concerned HOCs/HoSs of NCCBM and selected students will called for internship.



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- After the completion of the Training/Internship, the students will give a presentation on the project which was undertaken during the Training/Internship and submit the project report to NCCBM in PDF format. Thereafter a certificate will be issued from NCCBM after receiving "No Objection Certificate" through guide & HoC.
- Students have to manage their boarding, lodging and transportation for the entire duration of their Summer Training/Internship programmes at NCCBM.
- NCCBM will not pay any stipend to the students for summer training/internship/dissertation work.
- No extension is allowed in general. However, an extension may be granted in deserving cases with prior approval of the Competent Authority.
- An appropriate insurance has to be arranged by Institutes/students before starting the, Internship/Training and NCCBM shall not be liable for any other benefits.
- Students have to adhere to the timing of the institute and have to fill their attendance in the attendance register available at concerned departments.
